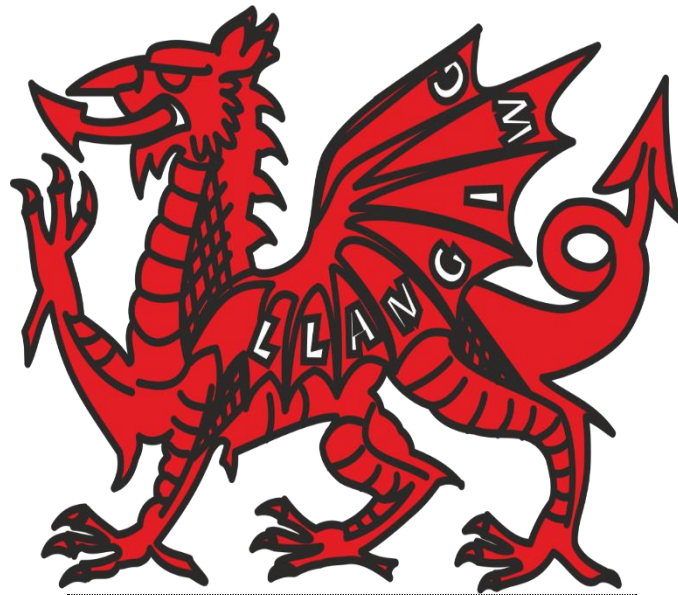

Snow and Icy Conditions/Procedure for Clearing Paths @ Llangiwg Primary School



Information for Parents and Carers about Site Management in case of snow/ice

We've put some information together for you which shows you how we'll look to manage the way into and out of our sites if there is snow or icy weather conditions. Please take a look at the information as it is important that we keep all users of our sites as safe as possible. Thank you for your assistance and understanding.

We want to keep everyone who uses our sites safe at all times, especially when the school grounds could be affected by snow or by ice. We are going to try to make sure that the paths are as safe as can be for all the people using the sites. Certain entrances and paths into school will be gritted on each site, other entrances or gates may be closed until conditions improve or the caretaker has a chance to make them safe later in the day. If there are icy or snowy conditions which are affecting the site you will get a text message to your mobile phone on the number you have provided to the school. **Breakfast Club** pupils will enter the school through the Upper Building entrance as usual.

Lower Building Safer Routes

Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will enter school through the Lower Building gate, down the ramp (which will be gritted) and wait at the main door instead of walking around the usual paths. As is usual, NO pupils/parents/carers are permitted to walk through the car park. If conditions improve, pupils will be able to go out through their normal exits at the end of the day. You will get a text message to tell you which exit will be used.

Upper Building Safer Routes

Year 3 -6 pupils will enter the Upper Building through the usual gate but must keep to the left and right-hand sides of the front yard which will be gritted. As is usual, NO pupils/parents/carers are permitted to walk through the car park. If conditions improve, pupils will be able to go out through their normal exits at the end of the day. You will get a text message to tell you which exit will be used.
